PARK BOARD: The Park Board will resume their regular meetings in April. With the help of volunteers they plan on constructing the storage shed that they were able to purchase with a CCSD#2 Recreation Board Grant.

MUSEUM BOARD: The Mayor appointed Joyce Menke, Tammy Page and Bill Jones to the newly formed museum board. The Board has applied for the CCSD#2 Recreation Board Grant. The museum is located at 303 Oak Street in the EMRE building. There will be a Grand Opening March 26th from 2-6:00PM. Everyone is welcome to attend.

SENIOR CENTER: The Seniors have reduced the price of the Elk Mountain telephone books to \$4.00. Stop by the Back Door Art Gallery, Senior Center or the Town Hall to purchase one.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL: The Mayor would like anyone interested in serving on the EDC Board to let him know or stop by the Town Hall to express your interest.

HIGH COUNTRY JOINT POWERS BOARD: The Landfill has requested that all garbage sent to the landfill be placed in plastic bags; no loose garbage in the town dumpsters. Any items that can't be placed in the dumpsters can be loaded on the trash trailer behind the town hall. Please check to see if they are items that have a disposal fee. The town is charged for these items at the landfill when we dispose of them. The town appreciates your help to cover the cost and that the items do not end up in the dumpster since they can cause damage to the trash truck.

FIRE DEPARTMENT: The Fire Department had election of officers-Chief Ryan Lewis, Assistant Chief Bob Meyer, Secretary/Treasurer Eli Hobbs, Captain Bill Sherwood and Captain Mark Wagner, The Department asks that you only put trees, limbs and leaves (not in plastic bags) in the burn pit behind the fire hall. Any other lumber or construction debris can be placed on the trash trailer behind the Town Hall.

COMMUNITY CENTER PROJECT: The conceptual drawing and cost estimates are nearing completion on the community center project. The town is looking at the grant options available through the Wyoming Business Council.

BROS-MEDICINE BOW RIVER BRIDGE PROJECT: The Town received the latest set of plans for review. They are planning on advertising the project in April and let in May with construction starting in October 2015. Once the project is let there will be a public meeting to introduce the contractor to the public.
